
Determine the need for rural communities and community organizations to have greater access to and interaction with other


- communities/organizations







Funding

- There is a strong sense that the network, if created, should be funded by a non-profit organization dedicated to rural Ontario development (88 respondents).
- ▶ The next most selected suggestions for funding are through:
 - the government (47 respondents)
 - volunteers (37 respondents)
 - membership fees (16 respondents).
